<p>Vision: Every student is engaged in rigorous instruction in a strengths-based classroom that uses real life experiences to maximize student learning.</p> <p>Mission: Build relationships, Be respectful, responsible, ready Motivate, inspire, and empower, Strive for excellence</p>	<p>In order to impact literacy and math performance, the Bonnie Branch staff will plan weekly in collaborative pairs using the strategic processes of Understanding By Design (UbD) and Classroom-Focused Improvement Process (CFIP) structures. UbD involves the practice of looking at learning outcomes in order to design curriculum units, performance assessments and classroom instruction. Using these structures enables teachers to employ best instructional practices to increase rigor and student engagement for each and every student. The staff will also conduct MAP goal setting sessions with individual students aligned with his/her needs and upcoming instruction.</p> <p>Key Actions to Support Strategies During planning, teachers will use an on-line structured form to incorporate UbD and CFIP structures for planning and data assessment.</p> <p>The Administrative team will conduct walk-thrus with all instructional staff focused on objectives, formative assessment, and lesson closure.</p> <p>Staff will access current MAP data and the NWEA Learning Continuum to support strategic instructional planning.</p> <p>Meaningful goal setting conversations will occur with every student in ELA and math classes.</p> <p>Teachers will use MAP data, formative, summative, and common assessments to plan instruction to meet students' needs.</p> <p>On-going professional development, "Bonnie Branch University," aligned with these strategies will be offered to staff throughout the year.</p> <p>Additional professional development is provided during weekly Program Implementation Periods. Staff is also encouraged to participate in HCPSS professional development sessions beyond the school day.</p>
