Registration Open: Howard County's 2019 Evidence-Based Parenting Classes

Howard County parents/guardians of 9 to 14 year olds are invited to join HC DrugFree and the Howard County State's Attorney's Office for our next Guiding Good Choices parenting 4-week program.

Participants will learn the skills to reduced the risk that their children will use drugs.

After completing the program, families will be able to: influence their children to help prevent drug use and other risky behaviors; develop clear family guidelines and expectations about drug use; and teach children how to stay out of trouble, keep their friends and still have a good time.
