

HCPSS Health and Safety Updates for 2021-2022 School Year

July 30th, 2021

Howard County Public School System Superintendent Dr. Michael Martirano today outlined several health and safety updates for the 2021-2022 school year, including that, effective immediately, masks will be required in school buildings for all students, staff and visitors, regardless of vaccination status. This decision comes after new guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the Howard County Health Department, all of which strongly endorse universal indoor masking.

Masks also will be required while on school buses. Masks will not be required for any students or staff while eating/drinking indoors. Masks will not be required outdoors, however they are recommended for unvaccinated individuals.

"This is not a decision I made lightly. Getting our students back to school in person is a top priority," said Martirano. "We recognize in this case that 'an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure.' I know not everyone is comfortable in a mask and appreciate our community's cooperation as we continue to fight this pandemic.

HCPSS Policy 8080

HCPSS permits students to bring personal technology devices to school, according to the following rules:

b. Middle Schools- Students:

i. Students will not use personal technology devices during non-instructional time, to include but no limited to transition between classes, lunch, recess, or in bathrooms.

ii. A school administrator may, on occasion, authorize the use of personal technology devices for special events and/or for positive behavioral supports and interventions.




