Together, the community and HC DrugFree's entire team of volunteers set a new record at HC DrugFree's location - 1,262 lbs. of medication were collected for proper disposal. Howard County Association of Student Councils (HCASC) is strongly encouraging middle school students to attend the meetings held the second Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. at Homewood School. The next meeting is November 13. Meetings are planned and administered by students with new business, BOE policy input, leadership training, guest speakers, and/or student forums where students can come together to share best practices and discuss current school and community issues. The HCASC is also responsible for coordinating the election of the student member on the BOE and is recruiting delegates to participate at the election convention. The boundary adjustment (i.e., redistricting) process is entering its final phase. There are numerous proposed changes happening at the working sessions, including revisions to proposed changes at the elementary

school, middle school, and high school level. If you would like to see some of the most recent proposals by BOE members, you should visit https://www.hcpss.org/school-planning/boundary-review/. There are three more working sessions:

- Thursday, November 7, 1 p.m.
- Tuesday, November 12, 6:30 p.m.
- Thursday, November 14, 6:30 p.m.
- Monday, November 18, 6:30 p.m. Preliminary decision

The BOE will make its final decision on November 21. BOE member Jen Mallo stated at PTACHC that there will be a final redistricting decision. The state of Maryland will not provide funding for High School #13 if the county does not show a good faith effort to redistrict existing schools to balance capacity.

The Board of Education will take action on the 2020-2021 academic calendar on Thursday, November 7. The BOE will decide between two proposed calendars. Calendar option #1 starts school for students on August 25, 2020 with the last official school day on June 10, 2021. Calendar option #2 provides for a student start date of August 31, 2020, and a final day of school on June 15, 2021. Both options provide for a full spring break week in April and include six inclement weather make up days at the end of the school year.

The next meeting of the Howard County Special Education Citizens Advisory Committee (SECAC) is on November 13, 2019. There will be a special guest presentation on Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Special Education with Dr. Kevin Gilbert. Please consider joining SECAC and attending the upcoming meetings. Maryland PTA is part of a coalition hosting community forums across the state focused on turning the Kirwan recommendations and new funding formulas into a reality. The Kirwan Commission recommends policies and funding that aid in providing the best public education possible to the youth of Maryland.
