- HCPSS is looking for students to join an SRO Focus Group:
 - Howard County Government and the Howard County Public School System (HCPSS) are sponsoring a series of engagements designed to hear from as many stakeholders as possible on the School Resource Officer (SRO) program in HCPSS. The first of these engagements is a virtual focus group for middle school students, high school students, and their families in schools with SROs. They feel it is important to hear from the young people who interact with SRO's on a daily basis while at school. The date of the virtual focus group will October 5, 2020.
 - A focus group is a demographically diverse group of people who participate in a guided discussion on a topic or subject.
 Interested participants should fill out this <u>application</u> no later than today, Thursday, October 1, 2020. Please make sure to answer all required fields. After the deadline, a randomly selected group of people will be chosen to participate in the focus group, divided equally among those who support SROs, are opposed to SROs, and have no position on SROs. The number of participants will be a representative sample of the number of applicants who submit. Information on the number of completed applications and the percentage selected to participate will be made public; however, the names of the participants will not be identified to protect the validity of the data collected.
 - To participate, students need parent or legal guardian approval to attend, and one parent or guardian willing to attend the virtual focus group with the student.

 - Please note, those not chosen to participate in this focus group will have an opportunity to give their feedback on SROs as part of a virtual town hall if desired. The town hall is scheduled on November 12, 2020.
